Subject: Regulations pertaining to Security and Conduct in the Panola County Detention Center

The volunteer work that you are performing is being accomplished inside the walls of the Panola County Detention Center. There are strict rules and regulations, which must be adhered to by all persons performing a service within this facility.

Some of the inmates which you will be in contact with represent different and perhaps, unusual personalities and drives, and perhaps some might attempt to take advantage of civilians in an attempt to make unauthorized contacts, to send messages without approval, and perhaps to arrange loans or gifts of money or anything that would be considered contraband material by the staff of this institution. Very frequently, they will attempt to use civilians who might not suspect anything irregular about a particular request. We feel that it is only proper to bring your attention to the fact that attempts of this kind will be made, and for this reason, we are listing some of our regulations pertaining to such activity.

- 1. The presence of any kind of intoxication, spirituous or malt liquors, including wines or beers of whatever alcoholic content is strictly prohibited. The presence of any kind of narcotics, drugs, hallucinogens, barbiturates, or paraphernalia pertaining thereto on the grounds of this facility, or any part thereof is strictly prohibited.
- 2. The members of your organization will refrain from discussing personal affairs with any inmate and not allow inmates to be overly familiar with you.
- 3. Do not strike or lay hands on an inmate unless it be in defense of yourself.
- 4. Do not convey any messages into the institution to an inmate, or outside the institution for an inmate, either written or oral.
- 5. Do not at any time have in your possession while in the Panola County Jail any firearms, knives or weapons of any type.
- 6. No instruments of any kind will be allowed in the facility.

It is against the law to introduce or attempt to introduce into this institution, or take or attempt to take or send from this institution any article without the knowledge or consent of the Sheriff or his duly authorized representative.

To Whom It May Concern,

Sheriff Cutter Clinton is pleased to continue the jail ministries program. The Panola County Detention Center offers in-person church services every Sunday to all inmates housed within our facility. We are currently accepting applications from our local church groups who wish to participate in the jail ministry services. We are extending the deadline for applications this year to May 15th, 2024.

Each church member who would like to volunteer to minister to the inmates will have to complete the Application for Religious Activities, the Authorization for National Crime Investigation Center check, and sign the acknowledgment of the Rules and Regulations. These three forms are included in the application packet. These three items will need to be completed for everyone in your organization that wishes to minister to the inmates during the Sunday Services. Completed applications may be turned in at the Panola County Detention Center to Lt. Scott Jones.

Upon processing and approval of a church group's application, we will place the approved group members on a rotating schedule. When the group's scheduled weekend arrives, only two members from the organization will be allowed into the facility to conduct the service with the inmates. If any organization is not able to meet these requirements, they will be excluded from the rotating church services list.

I wish to thank all of you who have volunteered your time to participate in the jail ministry over the past year. I believe it has been beneficial for everyone involved, and that it will continue to cultivate positive effects in the future.
